

## **Arts Council of Oklahoma City Membership Services**

The Arts Council of Oklahoma City provides a number of services with the goal of supporting the efforts of arts and cultural organizations in our community. Membership levels are designed to allow for a diversity of arts, cultural and community organizations to be part of this broad network which supports arts and cultural development in Central Oklahoma. In addition to the membership Services offered, the Arts Council of Oklahoma City continues to work with the Cultural Development Corporation of Central Oklahoma and Allied Arts to develop and initiate fresh approaches and new ideas to promote and support the arts in Central Oklahoma.

To be eligible for membership, your organization must be:

- A non-profit 501(c)(3) (please attach IRS determination letter)  
-OR-
- An institution of higher education that provides performances, exhibits, events, education programs and services in the Metropolitan Oklahoma City area.

There are two membership levels from which to choose:

### **Comprehensive Membership**

\$100 Annual Fee

**Eligibility for Festival of the Arts Food Row Partnership** –provides eligibility to be considered a Food Row non-profit partner

**Meeting Space** –available at McAlpine Center at affordable rates

**Cultural Connections Events** –scheduled during the year, providing members’ staff and volunteers the opportunity to discuss topics relevant to their operations and to network with colleagues.

**Eligibility for Membership at Oklahoma Educators Credit Union** –allows for membership at local credit union
